1 Quick Wins

Perfect for those short bursts of time

- ✓ **Set up their Enthuse fundraising page**
Encourage fundraisers to personalise their page with a photo and their story about why they're taking on this incredible challenge for your charity. A personal touch can make a huge difference.
- ✓ **Match funding**
Ask fundraisers to check with their employers to see if they offer matched funding, this would effectively double contributions.
- ✓ **Share a QR Code**
Fundraisers can share their fundraising page's QR code so people can easily donate without having to search for the page.
- ✓ **Adding the fundraising link to an email signature**
Encourage fundraisers to include a link in their email signature to make it easy for people to donate.
- ✓ **Post updates**
Fundraisers can share regular updates of their training on social media to keep supporters engaged and remind them of their fundraising progress.
- ✓ **Keep sharing!**
Remind fundraisers to ask their friends, family, and colleagues for support to help them reach their goal! It's fine to keep asking!

- ✓ **Hosting a Film Night**

- ✓ **Auction off promises**
Can your fundraisers auction off some good deeds for the highest donation? Dog walking, gardening or car washing perhaps? Or maybe tea and coffee duty in the office.

- ✓ **Dress Up/Down Day**
Organise a dress-up or dress-down day at work, university or social clubs, participants can donate to join in.
- ✓ **Hosting a raffle**
Fundraisers can reach out to local businesses for prize donations and organise a raffle to raise funds for your cause.
- ✓ **Organising a Quiz Night**
Fundraisers can host a quiz at a local venue or online, charging an entry fee. Include a raffle to raise even more!
- ✓ **A running courier service**
Fundraisers can combine their training with fundraising by offering to deliver items within their community during runs in exchange for donations.
